**Awards**

The Civil Service awards are open to archers with full membership of the Civil Service Sports Council (CSSC) or the Northern Ireland Civil Service Sports Association (NICSSA).

<b>Indoor</b>	Trophy and Medal for the 1 <sup>st</sup> Lady and Gentleman. Other Medals according to entry.
Recurve	Trophy and Medal for 1 <sup>st</sup> Veteran (aged 60 or over)
Compound	Trophy and Medal for the 1 <sup>st</sup> Lady and Gentleman. Other Medals according to entry.
Longbow	Trophy and Medal for the 1 <sup>st</sup> Lady and Gentleman. Other Medals according to entry.
Teams	Trophy and Medals for the 1 <sup>st</sup> Regional Team(s) for Recurve (3 Archers, which may include longbows) Compound (2 Archers) Medals for 1 <sup>st</sup> National (Departmental) Team of 3 recurve archers but can include longbows
Associate Members, Visitors and Juniors	All the above Trophies and Awards are for Full Members of CSSC or NICSSA. Please make sure that you include your CSSC Region and Civil Service Department on your entry form. Teams must be declared before sighters. Smaller Departments with like functions may combine to form a team. Non Full Members of CSSC or NICSSA are welcome to shoot but are not eligible for the above awards, medals will be awarded according to entry.
<b>Clout</b>	Medal awards will be according to entry.
