The Civil Service awards are open to archers with full membership of the Civil Service Sports Council (CSSC) or the Northern Ireland Civil Service Sports Association (NICSSA).

Indoor Trophy and Medal for the 1st Lady and Gentleman. Other Medals according to entry.

Recurve Trophy and Medal for 1st Veteran (aged 60 or over)

Compound Trophy and Medal for the 1st Lady and Gentleman. Other Medals according to entry.

Longbow Trophy and Medal for the 1st Lady and Gentleman. Other Medals according to entry.

Teams Trophy and Medals for the 1st Regional Team(s) for
Recurve (3 Archers, which may include longbows)

Compound (2 Archers)

Medals for 1st National (Departmental) Team of 3 recurve archers but can include longbows

All the above Trophies and Awards are for Full Members of CSSC or NICSSA. Please make sure that you include your CSSC Region and Civil Service Department on your entry form. Teams must be declared before sighters. Smaller Departments with like functions may combine to form a team.

Associate Members, Visitors and Juniors

Non Full Members of CSSC or NICSSA are welcome to shoot but are not eligible for the above awards, medals will be awarded according to entry.
