You are invited to compete in the Civil Service Regional Championship to determine the Lady and Gentleman Champions of the South West. The champions and runners-up will be chosen to make a team of four for the National Championship to be held in September. (Note that at present only recurve archers are eligible for funding).

CSSC will consider funding Regional Compound Teams if it is justified by sufficient numbers of compound archers supporting Regional Championships. If you want Compound Teams at the Nationals then support the Regional Championships.

In addition to the Civil Service Archery Regional Championship, there will be a separate regional competition for Post Office archers.

All archers must be affiliated to the GNAS and the GNAS Rules of Shooting will apply. It would be appreciated if archers would comply with the GNAS rules of dress.

Visitors are welcome, and separate medals will be presented, depending on numbers.
